Sustainability and Transportation Technology Conference (SETT)

Transportation technologies (e.g., CAV) and new approaches to mobility (e.g., shared) are advancing so fast that it can be difficult for policy makers to frame incentives, regulations, and market signals to promote all three pillars of sustainability: equity, the environment, and the economy. The SETT conference will address questions around how policy-makers, the private sector, NGOs, academics, and others can work together to encourage new mobility solutions to benefit all users of our transportation systems.
